It came from medieval China, spread to Europe and didn't reach America until the 1600s. The Outland Hearth breads have the nutty flavor and the earthy-gray color of the buckwheat fruit seed, and emit aromas that are both homey and exotic: toasted hazelnuts, vanilla buds, aged honey. With its caramelized crusts, and fragrant crumb, BREADBAR's buckwheat loaf tastes delicious with cheese, grilled fish, chicken and vegetarian dishes.
